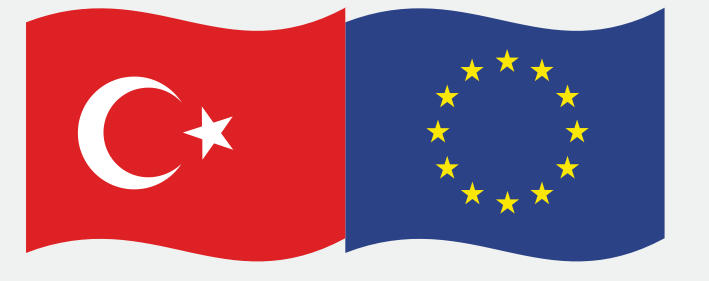

Purpose

We aimed to provide support for the daily needs of individuals living in the region affected by the earthquakes.

Target Audience

The target group for our solidarity activity consisted of individuals affected by the earthquake, the apprentice students and teachers at our school and the school administrators, our adult trainees and our master trainers.

25 apprentice students, **100** public education centre trainees, **35** master trainers, **13** teachers and **9** administrators worked on the project.



- **241** sleeping bags, **520** quilt cover sets and **2,900** items of clothing were sewn and distributed,
- **1000** bottles of shampoo were distributed,
- Packs of provisions made up of basic foodstuffs were delivered to **2,267** families,
- Hygiene sets were distributed to **2,727** families,
- **3** sets of field toilets with separate compartments for women and men were assembled and delivered to the earthquake region.

We sewed sleeping bags, quilt cover sets and clothes for families who had lost their homes and belongings during the earthquakes. We had these goods delivered to the earthquake zone.



We prepared packs of provisions containing basic foodstuffs and distributed them to families.



We distributed bottles of shampoo and hygiene sets to meet the hygienic requirements of families accommodated in camps and container settlements



Through the work of teachers and students in the field of metal technologies, we constructed three sets of toilets with separate sections for women and men. We arranged for the toilets to be set up in the camps and container settlements in Hatay.

What do beneficiaries and practitioners think about the project?

For us, it was a humanitarian duty to reach out to the earthquake victims and show them solidarity.

To be a source of hope for the people living in the earthquake zone – to touch their lives just a little – was priceless.

We received support from many institutions and we realised that our capacities for solidarity had grown much greater.

It meant a lot to us to support our brothers and sisters who have had to suspend their dreams for tomorrow in holding on to today.
