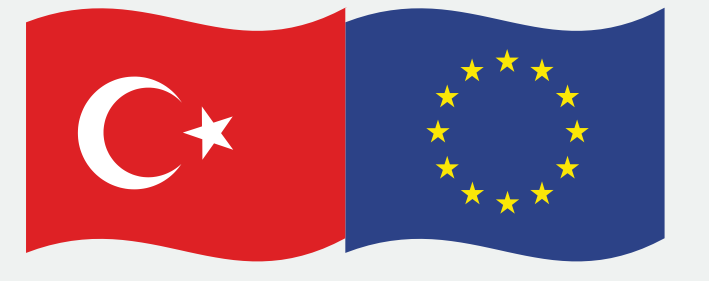

## Purpose

We aimed to provide support for the personal care needs of people in the region affected by the earthquake.

## Target Audience

Individuals affected by the earthquake, the apprentice students in our schools, the teachers and school administrators, our adult trainees and our master trainers formed the target group for our solidarity effort.

A total of **19** apprentice students, **76** public training centre trainees, **34** master trainers, three teachers and **14** administrators worked in the Post-Earthquake Period Solidarity effort.



- Hair cutting, beard trimming, hair dyeing, hand and nail care, skincare and other personal care services were provided to **2,405** people in all.

First, we established teams to provide personal care services to individuals affected by the earthquake. The teams were made up of volunteers from the vocational training centres taking part in the Vocational Training Programme for Employment (VET4JOB) and from the vocational training courses for adults.



We set up personal care spaces in the temporary accommodation centres and tent and container settlements and installed personal care equipment in these spaces.



We provided personal care services to children, women and men in the personal care spaces that we had set up.



For earthquake victims undergoing treatment, we also provided personal care services in hospitals.

## What do beneficiaries and practitioners think about the project?

We were very happy that our professions were useful in the solidarity work for the earthquakes.

We touched the lives of children, women and men affected by the earthquake. We aimed to make them feel valued with the services we provided.

I think the services provided strengthened our social bonds and helped us to return to our normal lives.

When we provided personal care services to people affected by the earthquakes, we became stronger both as human beings and as candidate barbers and hairdressers.
