### Purpose

We aimed to upcycle what we received from our planet by creating new materials from materials that were seen as idle or waste, and to raise awareness on these issues.

## **Target Audience**

The target audience of our project consists of students and teachers in our school, students and teachers in the school we cooperated with, and all the beings around us affected by waste, especially plastic.

**60** apprentice students, 33 primary school students, and 3 teachers worked for the project;



- **7** kilos of plastic waste were upcycled,
- 40,4 kilowatts of energy were saved,
- 12.120 grams of greenhouse gas emission was prevented,
- **Z** chess sets and bags were produced.



We changed the forms of the plastic wastes we collected from our school and the primary school we cooperated with. Using these plastic wastes, we made chess pieces on 3D printer benches with the design of our students and the contribution of the high school we received support from.



Our students designed a chessboard from the idle wooden student desks in our school and we produced the chessboards in the workshop of the company we collaborated with.



We conducted meetings with fashion design technologies students and teachers, and supported them to design and produce chess set bags from waste fabrics.



We gifted the chess sets to the primary school that supported our effort. With this project, in which individuals of different age groups collaborated, we developed our muscles of solidarity for our planet.



### What do beneficiaries and practitioners think about the project?



It was very helpful to talk about waste with people from younger age groups.

I look at what is called garbage

much differently now. There are endless ways to reuse everything we throw away, and I am very grateful to the solidarity process for teaching me this.
